

Airborne Illness Policy

This policy is for US-based trainings.

Individuals and their families should make risk- and benefit-based analysis determining if an online or inperson training is right for them. SEI has the following airborne illness precautions in place. Along with this policy, SEI will follow any mandates set by the CDC, state, city, and venue. This policy is subject to change.

- 1. Attendees understand that their participation in or involvement with the Training may present a health risk to themselves. Attendees accept full liability for their participation and involvement with the Training.
- 2. Proof of vaccines are not required to attend in-person trainings.
- 3. SEI recommends self-testing and staying home when feeling ill. Masks and social distancing when possible are recommended. Attendees with concerns about Covid 19 or other airborne illnesses should purchase their own tests and masks.
- 4. If an attendee tests positive for Covid 19 they will leave the Training immediately and inform the Coordinator. Names will not be mentioned unless agreed to by the attendee, but the Training will be notified that a positive case occurred. All other attendees can then make the best decision for themselves.
